## Our Judge - Glynn Payne

The judge for our Championship show 2018 is Glynn Payne, owner of the Fearnought kennel. Glynn has owned Bulldogs since 1984, his most notable dogs being CH Fearnought Born To Be Blue and the ticket winning Fearnought Sumo Warlord. He has also owned Mastiffs and a Finnish Spitz and has had champions in all three breeds.

A championship show judge in five breeds Glynn gave his first tickets in Bulldogs at Manchester in 2003, Since then he has judged the breed at B.U.B.A., Richmond, The Bulldog Club (Incorporated) and the British Bulldog Club as well as overseas in most of Europe, America, Russia, South Africa and the Far East.

Glynn served as President of the Junior Bulldog Club for fifteen years 1998 - 2013, He has also, over the years, held office in the South Of England Bulldog Society, The Mastiff Association, The Old English Mastiff Club and Southern Counties C.A. As well as being a leading official of the Canine Supporters Charity which holds the annual Contest Of Champions.

Although now living in Spain, Glynn's continued involvement in the world of dogs means that he is a regular visitor to his home-land and to the British ringsides.

Glynn judged the L.B.S. Open Show back in 1999 so we hope that you will welcome him back to this our 2018 Championship Show with an excellent entry and packed ringside.
